Come for the art, stay for the pickleball and live music. "All the art here is a Trojan horse," said Gareth Maguire, Dreamland's artistic director. "We're using it to try to bring people together." Opened in March 2021 by philanthropist (and pickleball enthusiast) Steve Kuhn, Dreamland is situated at the old Richard's Rainwater site, on 64 acres of natural terrain in Dripping Springs. Rainwater cisterns from the former rainwater bottling plant have been transformed into artists' canvases. Mosaics, paintings, and statues exploring an "American dream" theme dot the landscape. Visitors can play a game of pickleball or a round of miniature golf. The bar features 50 Texas beers and ciders and 40 wines, all accessed through self-pour taps using RFID-chip cards to keep track of ounces.
